

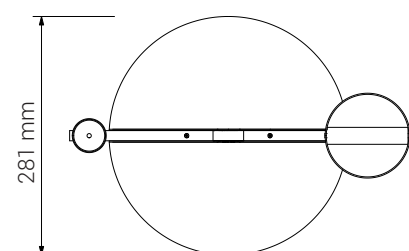
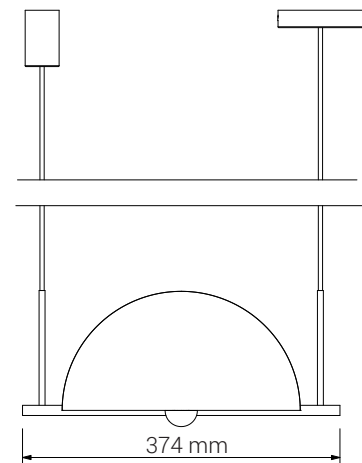


TRAPEZE PENDANT

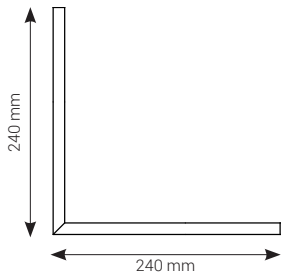
Trapeze is as much a single pendant as it is an endless system of possibilities. The square tube has a build in connector which make it easy and fun to mount multiple lamps together. You can connect two lamps next to each other or use a straight and/or a 90-degree connector.

PARTS

To attached one Trapeze with one or more lamps you need to use one of the two connectors. It is not possible to connect two lamps next to each other without a connector.



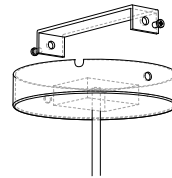
90 degree connector
JSTR2003-C90



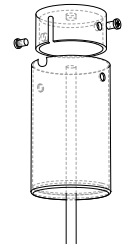
Straight connector

HANGING / FIXATION

Every single pendant need to have two fixation points in the ceiling, one with power supply and one without. Even if hanged together and connected with other lamps.



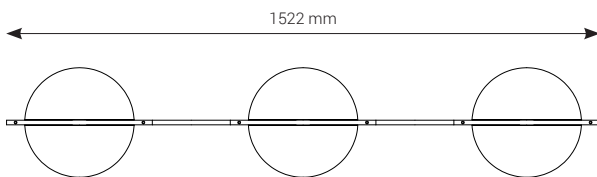
Ceiling cup with electricity

TRAPEZE TRIPLETTE

This configuration consists of three single Trapeze pendant (JSTR2003) and two straight connectors (JSTR2003-C0). It needs six fixation points, three with power supply and three without.



TRAPEZE BESPOKE

Trapeze can be configured in multiple ways by using the two connectors. You can connect as many pendants you like but always need one power supply and one fixing point (without power supply per pendant. You also need to have one (no more no less) connector between the lamps.

Below drawing is just an example.

TRAPEZE QUARTETTE

This configuration consists of four single Trapeze pendant (JSTR2003) and four 90 degree connectors (JSTR2003-C90). It needs eight fixation points, four with power supply and four without.
